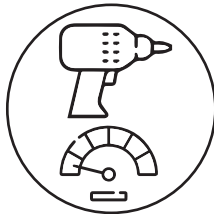
Tool Check

Check contents to ensure that you have the specified quantity for all identified parts and metal fittings.



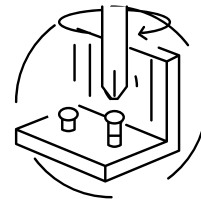
Safety Check

We recommend the use of a power drill on a low-speed setting for quick assembly.



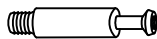
Easier Assembly Tip

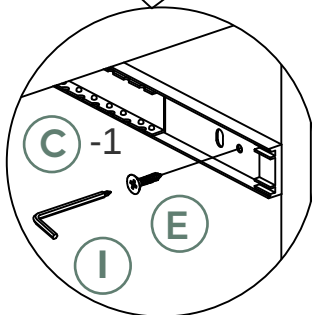
Pull out the inner rail (drawer rail) from the outer rail (the slider casing) that is attached to the cabinet.

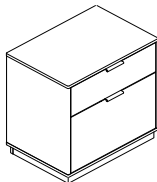


GREAT JOB. YOU'RE DONE!

To move the assembled unit, please lift it up and do not drag to avoid breaking some parts and damaging the floor.



When assembling this Bedside Table, please ensure that all screws are tight. After one or two months, please recheck and ensure that all screws are still tight.

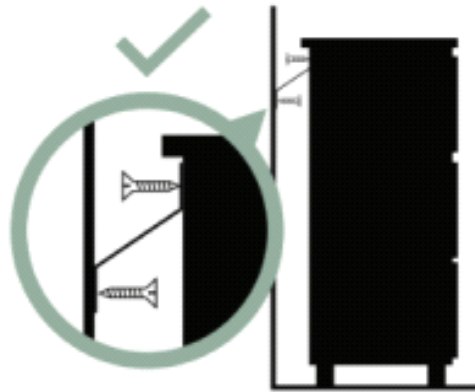


Our Bedside Table can hold weight of up to 25 kg. We don't suggest overloading it beyond its weight capacity.



WARNING

Children have died from toppling furniture – toppling furniture can cause serious injuries and death.



- **ALWAYS** secure this furniture with an anchor device.
- **NEVER** allow children to stand, climb or hang on drawers, doors or shelves.
- **NEVER** open more than one drawer at a time.

To prevent your furniture from tipping forward, it is strongly recommended that you securely attach this product to a wall or another solid surface, using an anchoring device and appropriate fixings.

IMPORTANT:

- Regularly check that anchors are securely maintained.
- We recommend that you use safety drawer locks (not supplied) to prevent children from climbing the furniture.
- Check whether the stability of tall items may be affected by thick pile carpet or uneven floors.
- Walls are constructed from different materials, for example, masonry (solid brick) or plasterboard lined cavity walls (hollow). It is important that you use the appropriate wall fixings for your wall type. Ensure to seek professional advice if you are unsure.

CARE INSTRUCTION

Follow these basic steps to protect your furniture.

Clean Gently

Use a soft, damp cloth and mild soap solution to wipe down surfaces regularly.

Temperature and Humidity

Keep away from heat sources like stoves and heaters. Avoid direct sunlight and prolonged exposure to high humidity/water. Maintain a consistent room temperature and humidity level.

Use Furniture Pads

Place furniture pads or felt protectors under the furniture to prevent scratches on floors.

Avoid Excessive Weight

Don't overload the Bedside Table beyond its weight capacity.
