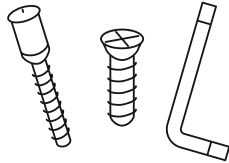

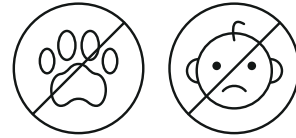

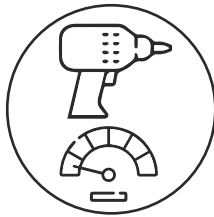
Tool Check

Check contents to ensure that you have the specified quantity for all identified parts and metal fittings.



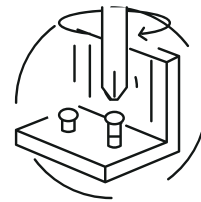
Safety Check

We recommend the use of a power drill on a low-speed setting for quick assembly.



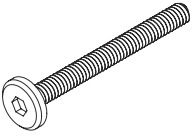
Easier Assembly Tip

When assembling this baby cot, please ensure that all screws are fastened tightly. After one or two months, please recheck and ensure that all screws are still tight.



Before using this baby cot, please verify the cabinet's structural stability.



Our baby cot can hold weight of up to 60 kg. We don't suggest overloading it beyond its weight capacity.

CARE INSTRUCTION

Follow these basic steps to protect your furniture.

Clean Gently

Use a mild wood cleaner or a mixture of water and mild dish soap to clean spills. Wipe the surface gently with a damp cloth, then dry it thoroughly

Temperature and Humidity

Avoid direct sunlight. Maintain a consistent room temperature and humidity level to prevent wood from warping or cracking.

Use Furniture Pads

Place furniture pads or felt protectors under furniture legs to prevent scratches on floors.

Avoid Excessive Weight

Don't overload the unit beyond its weight capacity.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTION

Congratulations on your new piece of furniture. We hope you will enjoy it for many years to come and we suggest that you follow the maintenance advice to ensure a long life for your furniture.

General instructions:

Before using the furniture please wipe with a clean, dry cloth to remove any remaining dust. To preserve the furniture's original appearance avoid rubbing, bumping or scratching the surface with any objects.

Maintenance:

Depending on the amount of use this product received, it may be necessary to tighten the fixings from time to time. This is normal for any flat pack furniture.

Cleaning:

For cleaning, use a cloth (not wet), dry duster and normal furniture polish.

The tools for assembly:

Part L "Allen Key" included in hardware pack.

NOTE:

Follow the guidelines in this user guide to ensure correct assembly and care for this product.

Pls do not use a power tool to assemble this product. Use of power tools may apply greater than necessary force on the fixtures, causing damage. Warranty is void if power tools have been used.

RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE

This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures 690 mm wide by 1300 mm long and 100mm in thickness. The width and length are specified because it is important that the gaps between the mattress and the sides and ends of the cot will not exceed 40 mm when the mattress is pushed to one side or end, and 20 mm when the mattress is centred in the cot. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500 mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimize the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

WARNING: TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MAXIMUM MATTRESS THICKNESS SHOULD NOT EXCEED 100MM

NOTICE BEFORE ASSEMBLING

We suggest you spend five minutes reading through this short notice before assembling and then follow the instructions step by step.

Point 1: Before assembling , please ensure that you have checked the contents for all relevant parts and counted all metal fittings quantities are correct according with our assembling instruction paper. If you find any accessories quantities are not correct, please kindly stop assembling it at once and take photos back to us.

Point 2: After you have checked all relevant parts and fittings quantities are correct, you would better put all metal fittings and other accessories concentration into one place, such as put into a utensil in case of missing any small fittings in assembling process.

Point 3: To ensure an easier assembly, we strongly advise that all fittings are only finger-tightened during initial assembly phase. Only upon completion of the assembly should all fixing points be fully tightened.

Point 4: We recommend a periodic check on all fixing points to make sure they remain fully tightened.

Point 5: Keep any metal fittings out of children's reach.

Point 6: Do not discard any of the packaging until you have checked that you have all the parts and the pack of fittings.

The need to ensure the cot is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points. and the need to keep medication, string, elastic, small toys or small items such as money, out of reach from any position in the cot.
